Roles and responsibilities of Lyppard Hub Board of Trustees

Lyppard Hub is a registered charity which has been in operation since March 1993. Its main aim is to be the focal point of the community, developing, implementing and enabling initiatives that enrich the lives of the local community and beyond. Lyppard Hub Trustees, often simply referred to as 'the board' have legal and financially responsible for the organisation as a whole.

What is a Trustee?

Trustees carry out a range of roles and duties that basically help the organisation to run well. Trustees make the major decisions affecting the organisation. They are responsible for setting out the strategic direction of the charity and must be confident that it is well managed and meeting its objectives. It is the trustees' responsibility to ensure the organisation is financially secure and complies to all relevant legislation.
